As a part of Pearl's legacy, Pearl's Hope provides housing and an array of support services for single mothers and their children. Most importantly, they assist in keeping families together. Because too many shelters cannot accommodate large families or boys over the age of 13, many families are forced to place their children with friends or relatives while mothers work to get back on their feet. Fortunately, the spacious living environment of the cottages at the Frances E. Willard Ministry Center, and Pearl's Hope, allows them to accept families of most any size and children (boys and girls) up to age 18. Please help with your support!
